Two suggested circular walks are shown on the map, both starting at the Black Horse Inn.

- The heath walk takes you up onto the chalk to see the wildflowers of the chalk in spring and summer, with fine views over the fen landscape in any season (3 miles/5 km).
- The fen walk heads out across the fen on the east side of the Lode, crosses it at the River Cam and returns on the western side (7.8 miles/12.6km). For a shorter walk, cross the Lode at Slades Farm to return in 4.7 miles/7.6 km.
